YES ON: I-001

PROTECT PARENTS' RIGHT TO KNOW



- **ENSURE IMMEDIATE NOTIFICATION:** Give parents the right to know when medical services are offered or provided to their child and when their child is the subject of an incident at school.
- **PRESERVE PROTECTIONS FOR STUDENTS:** Children in abusive or dangerous homes will remain protected under the law.
- **PROTECT PARENTS' RIGHTS:** Parents will have access to academic, medical, mental-health, and disciplinary records as well as lesson plans and teaching materials by voting yes on I-001.



YES ON: I-638

PROTECTING FAIRNESS IN GIRLS' SPORTS



- **PROTECT FAIRNESS:** More than 110,000 female athletes in Washington State could lose access to their sports to boys taking their places.
- **PROTECT PROGRESS:** Title IX was passed 70 years ago to protect and expand opportunities for female athletes that were afforded to males for years - allowing boys to take their places undoes years of progress for women.
- **PROTECT SAFETY:** All athletes deserve to compete in leagues that are safe and made for them - keep girls safe in the field of play and in their locker-room by voting yes on I-638.

VOTE YES TO REPEAL THE INCOME TAX



- **COMING FOR EVERYONE:** The income tax was built to apply broadly, and prominent Democrats have confirmed that it's likely that the tax will be expanded to all income earners.
